

## **Open Position in Clinical Psychology**

Boğaziçi University Department of Psychology invites applications for a faculty member in Clinical Psychology. We are looking for an individual who has substantial experience in academic and clinical settings. Preference will be given to applicants at the Associate Professor level. We expect candidates to have an active research program, and show excellence in teaching and clinical supervision. Applicants must be willing to offer various mandatory undergraduate courses as well as graduate courses in clinical assessment and clinical theory related to their psychotherapy approach. Experience in providing clinical services and active clinical practice is a must. Due to the need for supervising clinical graduate students who see clients in Turkish, priority will be given to Turkish applicants or to those with close to native-level Turkish, with good understanding of the sociocultural context. Candidates will be evaluated on the basis of academic excellence as well as the match between the applicant's areas of expertise and our department's immediate needs.

Boğaziçi University is a highly competitive public university in Istanbul, Turkey. It admits students ranked in the top 1000 of over 2 million applicants entering a nationwide university entrance exam. The Psychology Department is committed to academic excellence. The department offers both undergraduate and graduate degrees (M.A. & PhD) in Psychological Sciences and Clinical Psychology. The department supports collaborative research across several labs and research groups. Currently, the department has seven active research laboratories (Behavioral Neuroscience, Psychoepigenetics, Cognitive, Developmental, Baby and Child Development, Social, and Vision) and a Center for Psychological Services (BÜPAM).

The successful candidate must have demonstrated potential for academic excellence in both teaching and research productivity. The curriculum is in English and the typical teaching load is 2 courses per term. Candidates will be expected to teach undergraduate and graduate courses, develop a strong research program, and supervise both Master's and Ph.D. level research.

For Turkish candidates, the position is tenure-track with 3-year contracts. For foreign candidates, the position is for 12 months with a possibility of renewal upon positive review. The university provides on campus housing upon availability.
